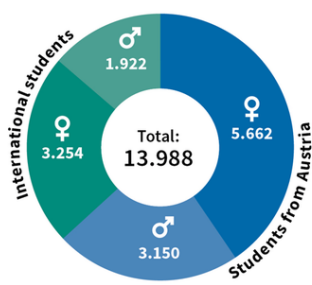

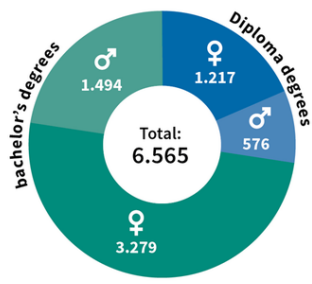

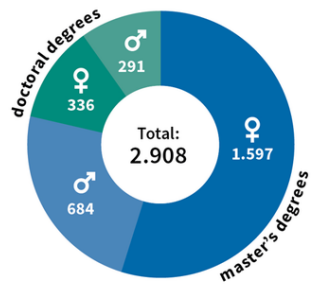
New entrants

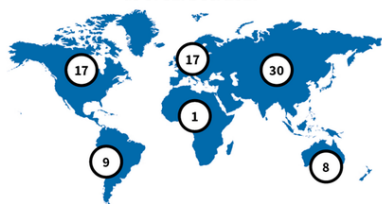
Degrees awarded

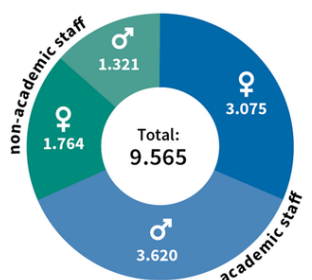

## Our Role in LEAD2

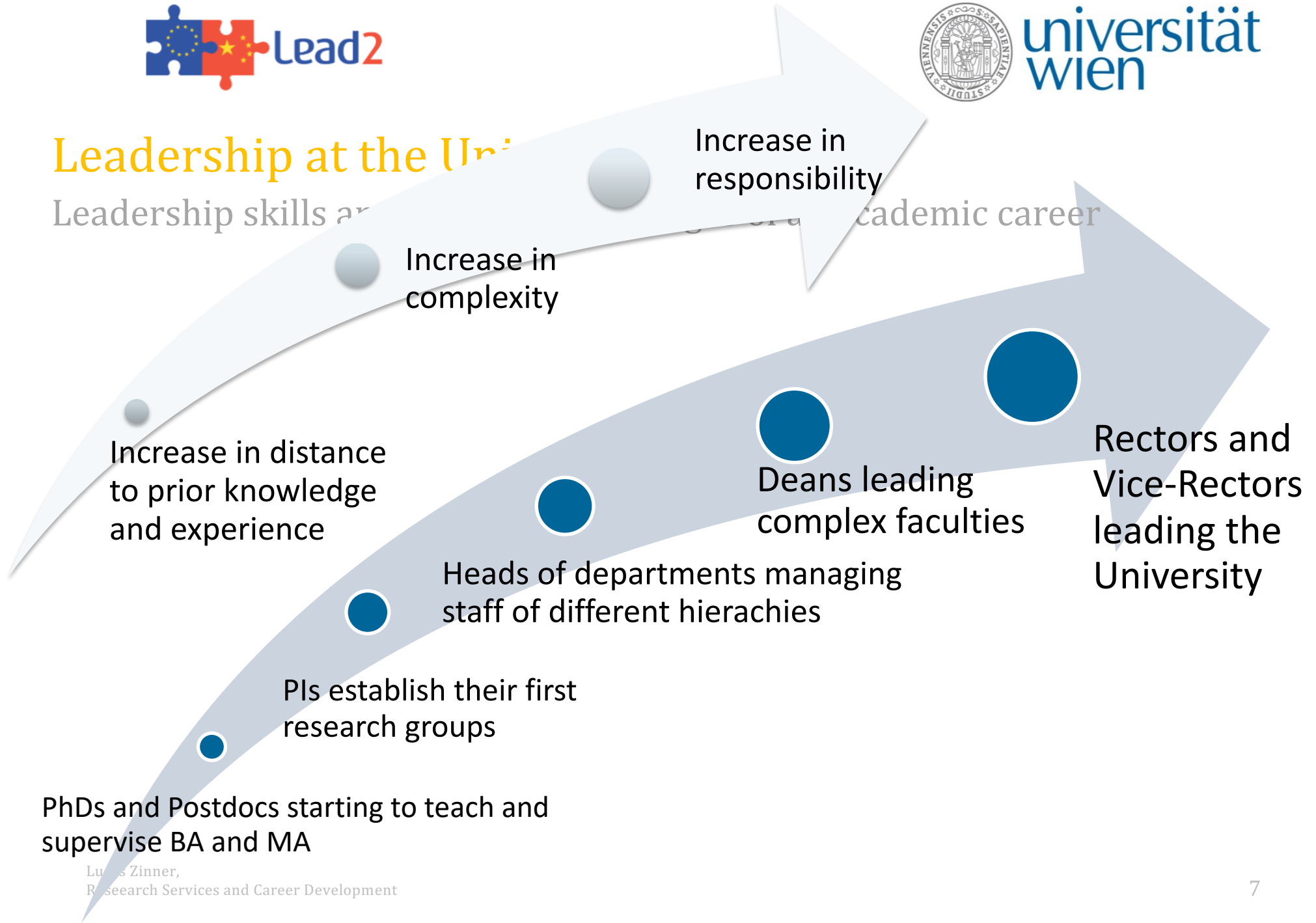
WP3: UniVie will support quality assurance and internal peer assessment;
