

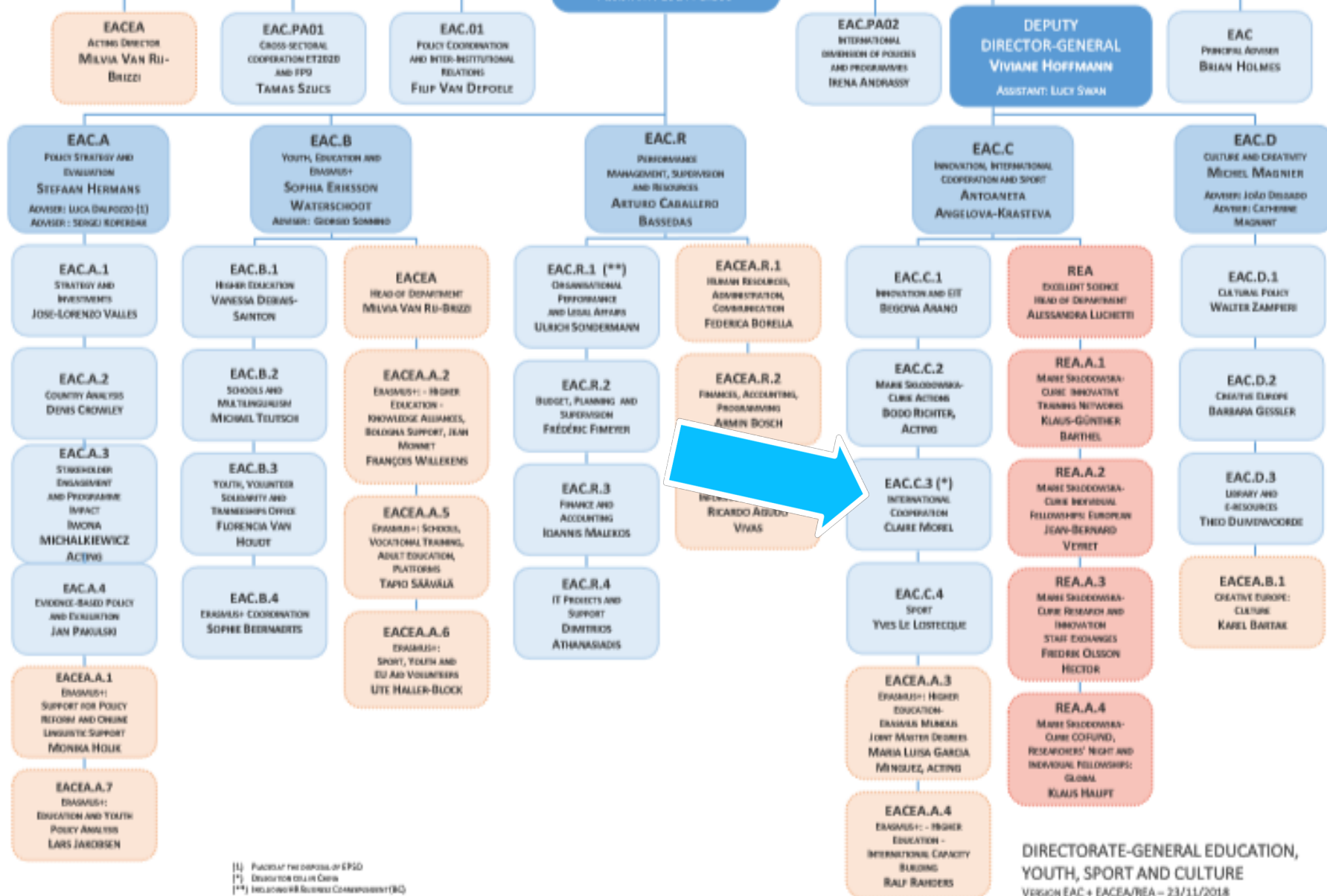

HPPD represents third pillar of EU-China relations (other two pillars: High Level Economic and Trade Dialogue and High Level Strategic Dialogue)

HPPD covers education, culture, youth, gender equality and sport

HPPD helps build mutual trust and consolidate intercultural understanding between EU and China

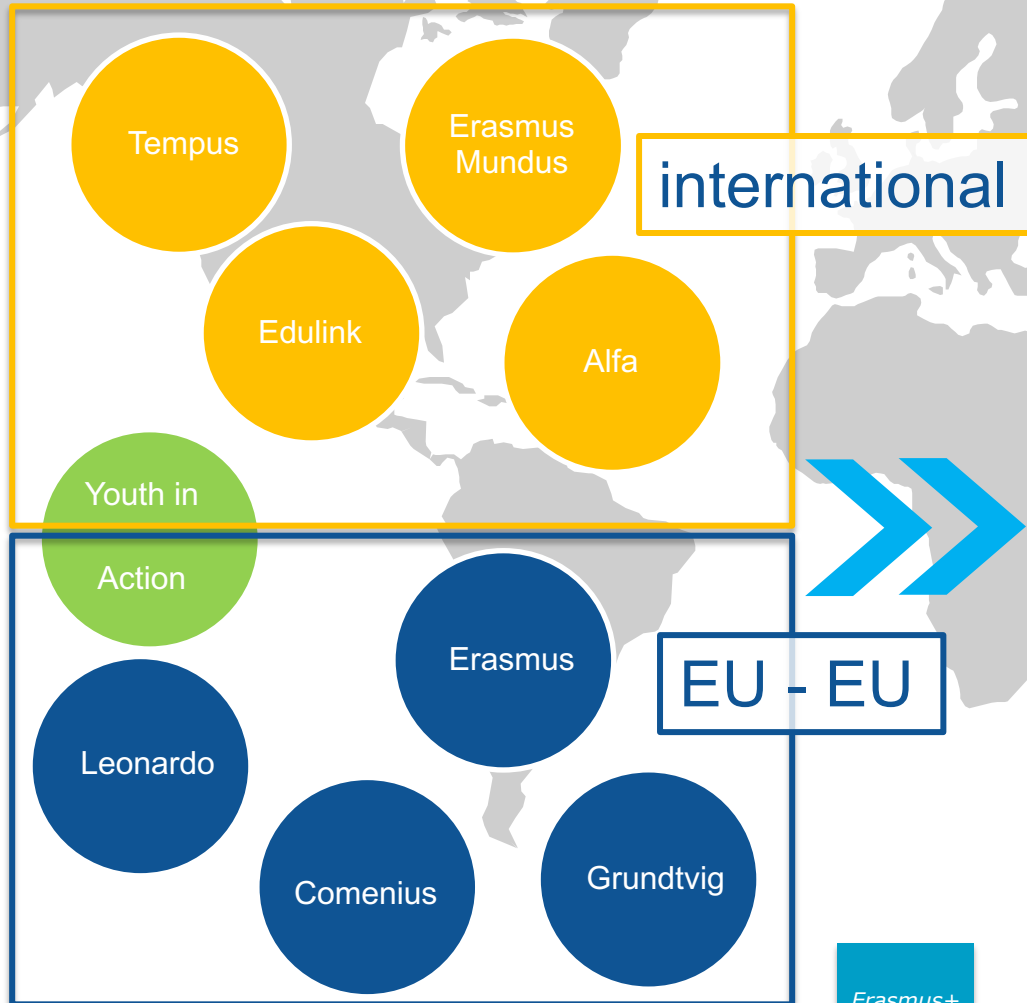

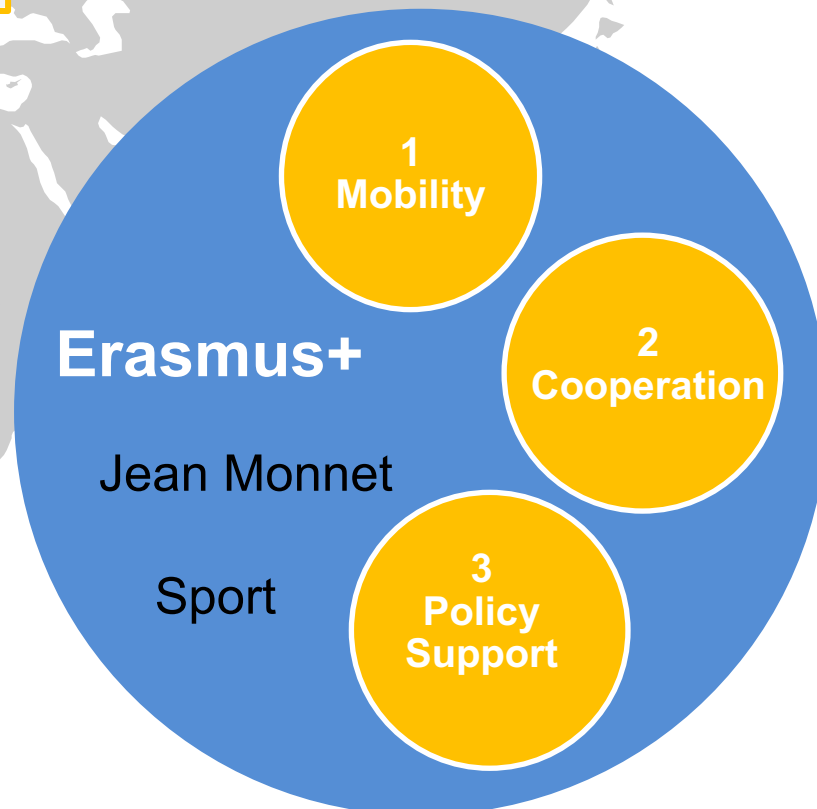

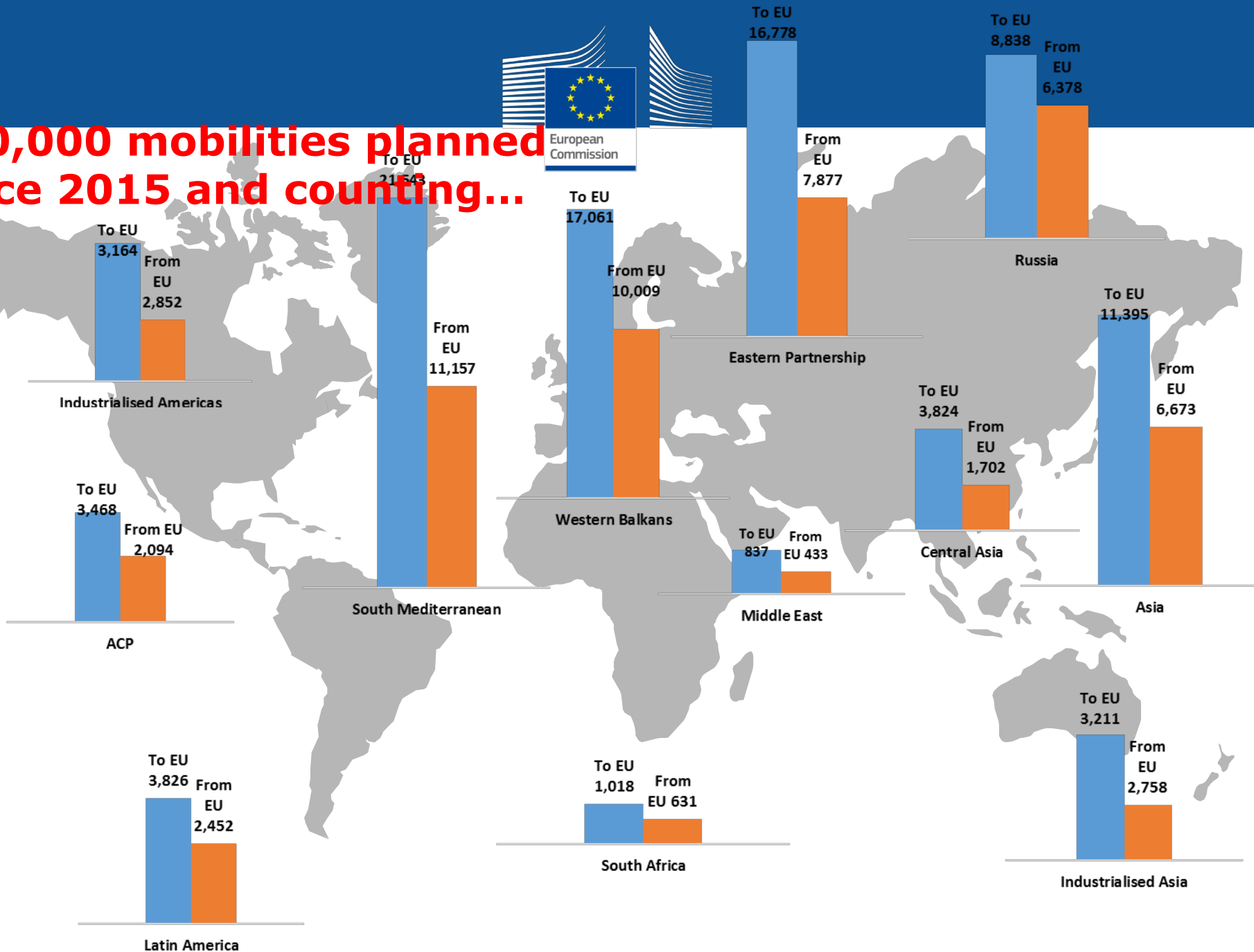
II. International Credit Mobility



- Short-term higher education mobility for:
 - **Students and PhD candidates (3-12 months)**
 - **Staff (5-60 days)**
 - **Trainees (2 to 12 months)**
- 150,000 grants over 6 years
- Action managed by National Agencies in Programme Countries
- 2019 budget 18.3 M EUR ~ 4500 scholarships



150,000 mobilities planned since 2015 and counting...



China Participation in ICM

First four years of implementation (2015-2018):

- Over 5000 beneficiaries (~23% of scholarships funded in the region)
- ~2/3 are Chinese learners/staff studying in the EU and ~ 1/3 are EU learners/staff studying in China

Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees



- Full master degree (1-2 years)
- Excellence
- Full scholarships
- 12, 18 or 24 months (60 – 90 – 120 ECTS credits)
- Double, Multiple or Joint Degree
- 2014-2020: 250 Joint Master Degree courses



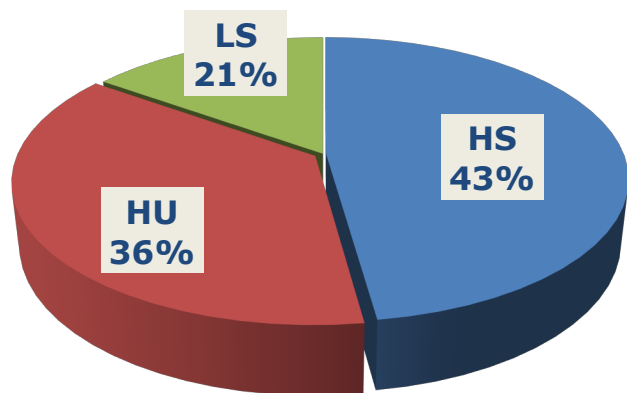
Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees

...in brief:

- Increased budget for the 7-years-period
 - around **1 billion €**
 - allowing to support **≈ 250 EMJMDs** and
 - **≈ 28.000 scholarship holders** - 75% for students from Partner Countries

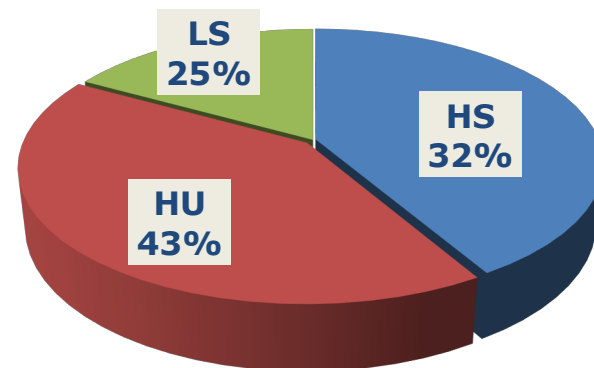

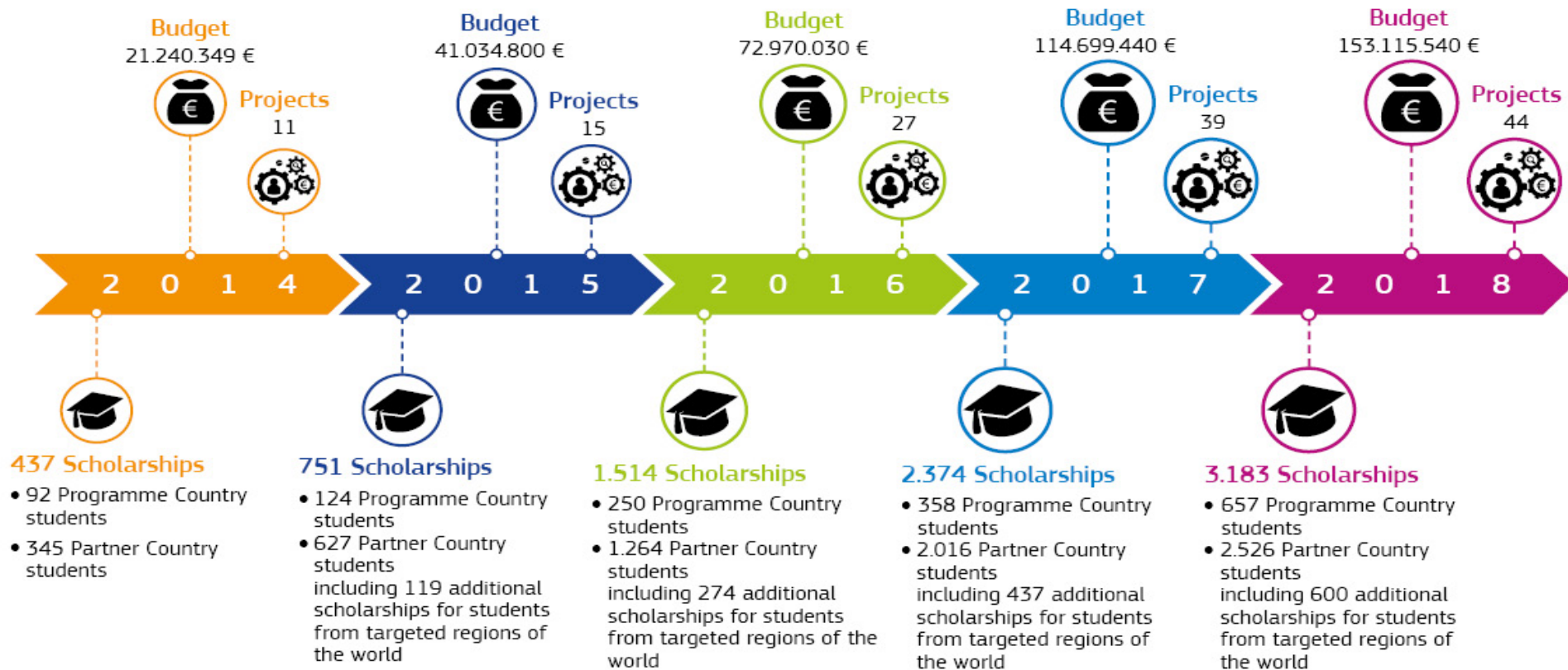

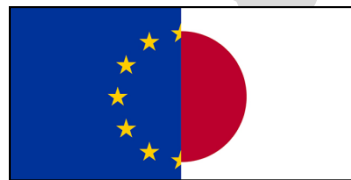
Existing frameworks: Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree (EMJMD) and Inter-University Exchange Project (IUEP)

Main purpose: select consortia to develop joint master programmes

Management: EACEA in Brussels + JSPS in Tokyo

Call deadline: 1 April 2019

Call Budget: 6 Million EUR
